Professor of Child Neurology at the University of Liège Head of the Institute I-Motion Head of Neuromuscular Centre in in Liège, Belgium



Prof. Servais runs a large SMA centre and have extensive experience with Nusinersen in the management of over 100 SMA patients.

He graduated from Louvain Medical School (Brussels, Belgium) in 1999, and obtained his PhD in Neuroscience in 2005 from Free University of Brussels, Belgium. He had his Child Neurology training in the Free University of Brussels and in Robert Debré Hospital, Paris, and became the Child Neurologist at the Institut de Myologie since 2008. Currently as the Professor of Child Neurology at the University of Liège, and Head of the Institute I-Motion in Paris, and Head of the Neuromuscular Centre in Liège, Belgium, he is leading the newborn screening program for SMA in southern Belgium, and has overseen numerous clinical trials to test treatments for Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy and Spinal Muscular Atrophy. His current major research includes the development of innovative outcome measures for real-life patients' evaluation.
